



GRAYSON COUNTY ARES SOP-1

Command Net Script

1. Preamble (announce frequently)

THIS IS [say your call here], MY NAME IS [say your name here] AND I AM THE NET CONTROL STATION FOR THE COMMAND/INFORMATION NET FOR THE [INSERT EVENT HERE] – **example:** SIMULATED EMERGENCY TEST]. THIS [INSERT EVENT HERE] – **example:** SIMULATED EMERGENCY TEST] IS BEING CONDUCTED BY THE GRAYSON COUNTY AMATEUR RADIO EMERGENCY SERVICE.

THE PRESENT STATUS OF GRAYSON COUNTY AMATEUR RADIO EMERGENCY SERVICES ACTIVATION IS (choose level below):

[LEVEL !GREEN! — INACTIVE]

[LEVEL !YELLOW! — ALERT STATUS]

[LEVEL !ORANGE! — STAND BY STATUS FOR DEPLOYMENT WITHIN THE NEXT FILL IN TIME HOURS/MINUTES]

[LEVEL !RED! — FULL DEPLOYMENT STATUS].

2. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THEIR HOMES.

THIS IS A DIRECTED NET AND YOU MUST GET PERMISSION FROM THE NET CONTROL STATION TO SPEAK.

OTHER REPEATER USERS ARE ASK TO HOLD ALL BUT EMERGENCY OR PRIORITY TRAFFIC.

STATIONS WITH EMERGENCY OR PRIORITY TRAFFIC MAY ENTER THE NET BY USING THE USUAL PRO SIGN "BREAK-BREAK", YOU WILL THEN BE IMMEDIATELY RECOGNIZED BY NET CONTROL.

IS THERE ANY EMERGENCY OR PRIORITY TRAFFIC AT THIS TIME?

AFTER CHECK IN's ARE TAKEN YOU WILL BE RECOGNIZED BY NET CONTROL BY USING THE LAST LETTERS OF YOUR CALL OR YOUR FULL CALL IF YOU HAVE A 2 X 1 OR A 2 X 2 CALL. PLEASE USE YOUR FULL CALL WHEN CHECKING INTO THE NET.

I WILL TAKE CHECK INS IN GROUPS OF FOUR, IF I DO NOT REPEAT YOUR CALL THAT MEANS THAT I DID NOT COPY YOU, SO PLEASE TRY AGAIN.

IF YOU NEED TO LEAVE THE NET BEFORE IT ENDS, PLEASE CHECK-OUT WITH NET CONTROL.

2. DURING THE NET:

ID frequently, at least every 10 minutes

[End each transmission with the FCC legal call sign WC5GC if any EOC is active.]

Station Check-in

[Stations call as they arrive on station. Simply acknowledge and log their entry time, etc.]

[You should use the FCC call of the other station.]

Station Roll Call

[At least once every 30 minutes or more often if not busy]

3. CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE AT END OF NET *****

AT THIS TIME I WILL GIVE THE FULL CALL, PLEASE RESPOND WITH YOUR FULL CALL TO CHECK-OUT.

[after all stations are checked out of the net]

ACTIVATION LEVEL IS: [choose one from list below]

[LEVEL !GREEN!—INACTIVE]

[LEVEL !YELLOW!---ALERT STATUS]

[Call all stations on the log using their FCC call.]
